

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students shall be admitted from the junior high school to the senior high school on recommendation of the junior high school principal. To graduate from the senior high school, 46 semesters of credit must be earned.

SPECIFIC CREDIT MUST BE EARNED IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS BY RECEIVING A PASSING GRADE.

ENGLISH / LANGUAGE ARTS	8 SEMESTERS
SCIENCE	6 SEMESTERS
MATHEMATICS	6 SEMESTERS
SOCIAL STUDIES (Including Gov't)	8 SEMESTERS
TECHNOLOGY	1 SEMESTER
PHYSICAL EDUCATION (Must take but does not count for credit / GPA)	8 SEMESTERS
ELECTIVES	17 SEMESTERS

Each student is required to take a minimum of six classes per semester. All subjects shall provide credit toward graduation requirements. Physical education is required but does not provide credit for graduation.

Students who have met graduation standards may take part in graduation ceremonies. The parents of students who experience scholastic difficulty sufficient to endanger graduation will be notified as soon as the situation becomes apparent. Periodic updates of progress will be given to the parents until the difficulty is resolved.

GRADUATING SENIORS MUST HAVE COMPLETED ALL COURSE WORK BY THEIR LAST DAY OF SCHOOL, PRIOR TO GRADUATION, IF THEY ARE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GRADUATION CEREMONIES. Students completing course work later than that may still graduate, but may not take part in the formal exercises.
