Our goal will be to provide and atmosphere for learning which is void of sexist, racist, and ethnic prejudices, discrimination and separatism. No student shall be denied enrollment in a class on the basis of gender, race, religion, color, national origin, marital status, age, sexual orientation, or disability.

It is also the policy of this district that curriculum content and instructional materials utilized reflect the cultural and racial diversity present in the United States and the variety of careers, roles, and life styles open to all regardless of gender, race, religion, color, national origin, marital status, age, sexual orientation, or disability.
